  - History and Aims of the group
  - Details of enhancement projects / activities undertaken
  - Long Term Contribution made by the group to the local area
  - Inter-community co-operation and involvement
  - Linkages with other community groups

Presentation time is limited to 10 minutes and a maximum of 3 participants from the group can attend the assessment. Powerpoint and laptop facilities will be available if required. It is proposed to hold the assessment on 31 March – 3 April, 2009 in the Council offices.

- ❖ **Single Issue Project**

Single Issue Project – entries in 2009 **must** come under one of the following themes:

- Heritage
- Youth
- Integration

The chosen theme must be indicated on the Application Form.

- ❖ **Population Category – Please see specific application form**

- ❖ Following the completion of the Sligo competition up to **five** groups may be selected by Sligo Local Authorities for entry into the **All Ireland Pride of Place Competition**.

- ❖ Judging will commence in the All Ireland competition mid June 2009.
