

## The registration process has changed. What's different?

- **Registering to vote for the first time is now possible online at [www.checktheregister.ie](http://www.checktheregister.ie)**  
Use of PPSNs facilitates identity checking meaning that now, most people won't have to visit a Garda station to have forms witnessed.
- **16- and 17-year-olds will be able to pre-register to vote**  
Introduction of a pending electors list enables those 16 and 17 to pre-register and be automatically registered when they turn 18.
- **You must be living full time in the State to be eligible to vote**  
We will ask you your nationality in your application as this may affect which elections you can vote in.

<b>An Irish citizen</b>	You are eligible to vote in all elections and referendums
<b>An EU citizen</b>	You are eligible to vote in European and local elections
<b>A British citizen</b>	You are eligible to vote in Dáil and local elections
<b>All other</b>	You are eligible to vote in local elections

### Want to register to vote?

Apply at [www.checktheregister.ie](http://www.checktheregister.ie) Choose this if you:

- Have your PPSN and Eircode available
- Are aged 18 or over and living in Ireland
- Are aged 16 or 17 and want to pre-register

### Some cases require a form

Select [www.checktheregister.ie/en-IE/forms](http://www.checktheregister.ie/en-IE/forms) Choose this if you:

- Don't have a PPSN
- Want to update your citizenship
- Want to apply for a special or postal vote
- Want to make a third-party request for a change to the register

### Already registered but need to update details?

Select [www.checktheregister.ie/en-IE/search](http://www.checktheregister.ie/en-IE/search) Choose this if you:

- Have your PPSN and Eircode
- Need to confirm your details
- Need to update your address
