Recorded Monuments and Places (RMP)

There are ten recorded monuments that are within 100m of the edge of the proposed route and have been accorded Cultural Heritage Constraint (CHC) numbers.

Rath: The bank is removed leaving only grass covered platform. An arc of scarp (L 70m; Width of slope 107m; H 0.5m) S-NNW coincides with the natural break of the slope at top of ridge. There is a terrace (Width 4.5m) at the base of the scarp from which the ground falls into a broad slope to the base of the ridge. On the E side of the site there is a ditch which appears to be a recent feature. O'Rorke (1878, 241) describes the site as 'a large rath or fort...oblong in shape". There is a souterrain in the S half of the interior. And a possible fulacht fia immediately to the W. 10/05/02

Souterrain: In the S half of the rath close to the scarp of the rath, at S. Low, roughly circular rise marked by long grass and brambles, from which stones protrude, especially on the E side. Within the S edge of the rise is a collapsed, roofless souterrain passage. (Width 1m; L 4m N-S; D 1m) – overgrown. At N end is an *in situ* lintel covering a low opening (H 0.3m) to a drystone - built passage which extends to the north. Roughly 10m to the N, protruding from the ground, are two further *in situ* lintels.

Holy well: Indicated on 1913 OS62 map at the S end of the rath, above. No remains of the well were positively identified, though a large slab is visible in the boggy ground at the S terminal of the scarp of the rath. May be the remains of the well. It is recorded that the 'patron day' of the parish is February 1st, St Brigids Day (OSL, 375).

The entrance, with evidence of a draw-bar-socket, is in the NE wall at the east end. There was a machicolation above the entrance of which only 2 corbels survive. Doorway is at external ground level but 0.9m above present internal ground level, pointing to the presence of a semi-basement. There are 2 fireplaces in the NW wall and one on the upper storey in the SE wall. There are large inwardly-splayed windows with low segmented arches in the NE and SW walls and smaller windows in the SE wall. There are loops flanking the fireplaces in the NW and SE walls and there is also a loop in the projection originally containing the stairs. The house is constructed of mortared, roughly cut sandstone blocks. Outside the house there are remnants of a small square enclosure or outhouse abutting the NW Wall. Note: The 17th century house at Castlebaldwin/Bellanagarrigeeny is recorded as a National Monument (File

No.C94:232/1/37) described as 'Castle'.

It extends 40m to S and SW of the enclosure in a wide shallow curve, more or less following the natural contours of the ridge. It is possible that preserves the line of an
