	A Year in Nature Communities engage in workshops focused on cycle of growth, connection to nature and field to fork.	2 workshops per season in your own local area, focusing on the growing seasons and connection with nature at that time (trees cycle in the year, plants, food, animals, bees, insects, cooking).
	Biodiversity Train the Trainer: Building on local knowledge to provide capacity for biodiversity awareness resource at local level.	1 x academic term, 2025 (to be confirmed). Support to local communities afterwards.
WELCOME	Supporting Local Prosperity/Local Ambassadors Bring communities together to support new arrivals, local pride in area by creating local ambassadors for visitors and new arrivals.	Training x 6 sessions based on local need. Learning more about services and attractions in local area to serve as welcome for new arrivals and visitors alike. Ambassadors volunteer on basis of when they can and booked in advance.
	Fix It Friday/Repair Cafes Support set up of repair cafes where local people with skills would prevent waste by providing people with minor repairs to small items and show people how to fix things up themselves.	Support for people with skills (2-3 x 2 hr sessions) and setting up. Evaluation of first trials. Cafes set up on monthly or pop-up basis as communities decide.
X	Shore to Shore/ History Minus the Mystery Supported exploration of local history – oral, folklore, mythology with resulting input to local festivals and events.	Supported programme. 12 sessions over 3-6 months. Events relating to outputs be that book launches, festival talks, performances. Can be linked to <i>Give it A Swirl</i> .
