It is with the up most importance that I object to the rezoning of land Reference SLG-C29-97

As mentioned above this piece for rezoning and I strongly disagree with this for the below reasons

There is a sligo council drain servicing all of Carrowhubbock North and South going through that site and into the bay. Any disturbance to this drain would be highly detrimental to all the surrounding land and households

There is a Ringfort (one of the most prominent in Connaught) on SL016-001001- Cliff Edge Fort, this is located beside the site to be rezoned, I do not want tourists trespassing Additionally, there are high unstable cliff edges which could incur fatalities If someone were to fall off these.

There is a burial site located on the grounds of the site to be rezoned. Please see attached image for reference SL016-091. Details of this can be found on archeology.ie

It is unethical to tamper on grave grounds!

Rezoning of this land is too far outside the town and will interfere with farmlands and country living.
