## **Development:**

Development consisting of an increase in the amount of waste accepted annually from 25,000 tonnes to 50,000 tonnes, the acceptance of commercial and domestic non-hazardous waste. The acceptance of household hazardous waste at the civic amenity area and commercial hazardous waste in the transfer building; the provision of additional waste receptacles in the civic amenity area and 3 no. Secure hazardous waste storage containers in the south eastern yard at its existing materials recovery facility. The development will require the review of the Industrial Emissions Licence granted by the Environmental Protection Agency. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) accompanies the application.

Location of Development: Deep Water Quay, Sligo

Sligo County Council made a decision to grant planning permission for the above development on the 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2017.

The applicant and any person who made submissions or observations in writing to the Planning Authority in relation to the planning application in accordance with section 37(1) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 – 2015 may appeal such a decision to An Bord Pleanála.

A person may question the validity of any decision of the Planning Authority by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986), in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended.

A person may question the validity of any decision on an appeal by An Bord Pleanála by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986), in accordance with Section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as amended.
